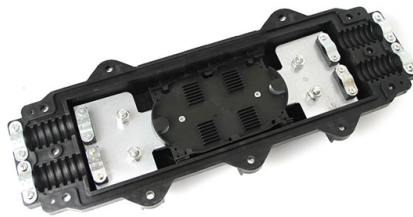
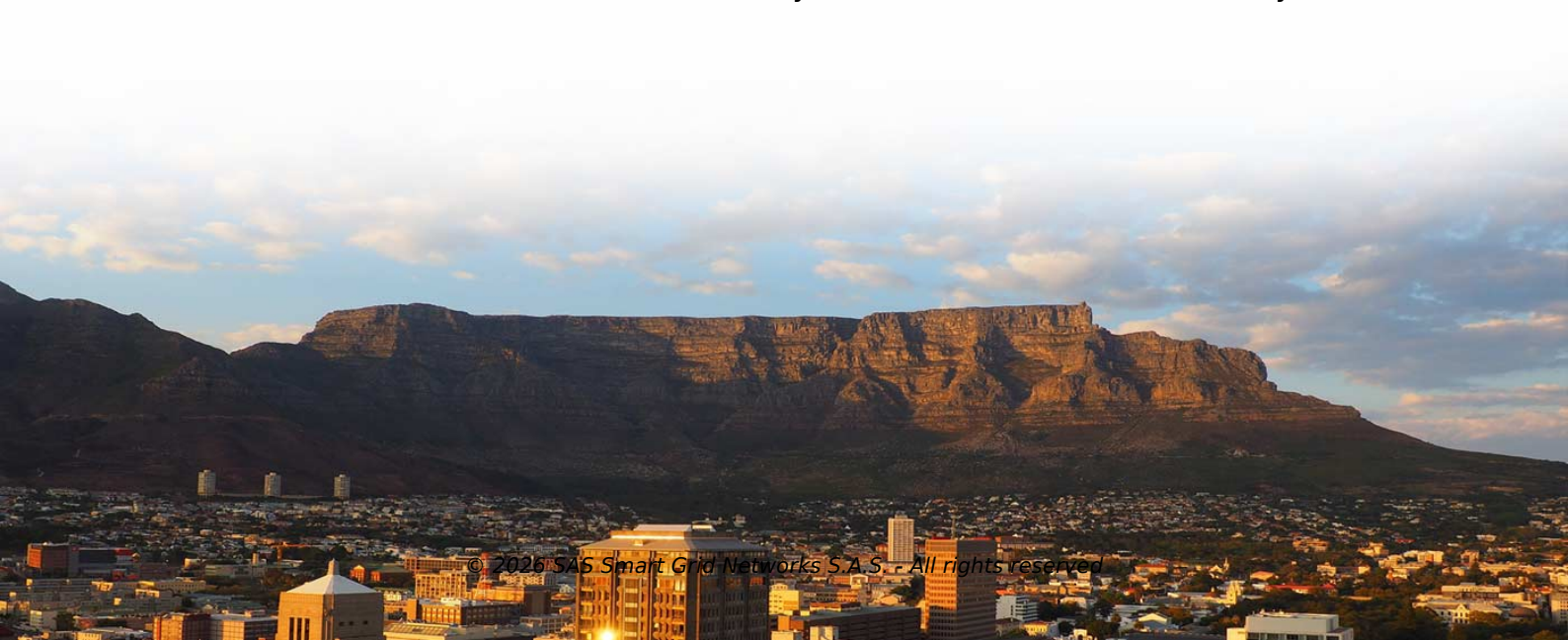


Civil defense electrical installation via cable trays
