

Excavation outside the direct-buried optical cable line



Overview

Check with local municipal or county building departments and any relevant Homeowners Association (HOA) for permitting requirements before beginning excavation. Underground cables are pulled in conduit that is buried underground, usually 1-1.2 meters (3-4 feet) deep to reduce the likelihood of accidentally being dug up. In extreme cold climates, cables may need to be buried at greater depths where temperatures are colder and frost penetrates to the ground. Loose tube cable is 600 lbF (2,700 Newtons). Refer to the cable specification sheet or to the cable's "Installation" and "Installation" (after installation). The following formulas may be used to determine general guidelines for installing Corning Optical Communications fiber optic cable; however, refer to the cable's specification sheet for more information. Fiber optic cable transmits data as pulses of light through thin strands of glass, offering superior bandwidth and distance capabilities compared to traditional copper wiring. This approach provides physical security. Recommendation ITU-T L. 101 describes characteristics, construction and test methods of optical fibre cables for buried application.
