The country is connected to five optical fiber submarine cables (SAT3, WACS, ACE, SAIL, and NCSCS). Yet it makes very little use of this equipment to develop its telecoms sector, as well as that of the sub-region. In 2023, Cameroon continued to rely on a select group of countries such as Italy, China, Ukraine, Spain, and Mexico for its fiber optic cable imports. The high Herfindahl-Hirschman Index (HHI) indicates a concentrated market, with limited diversification among suppliers. This figure reflects the total revenues of producers and importers (excluding logistics costs, retail marketing costs, and retailers' margins, which will be included in the final consumer.
