Handholes also known as telecom vaults or joint pits, are necessary for a fiber optic network route along its length to access the cable at periodic intervals. Sizes range from 12" -12". Early verification of minimum bend radius and maximum pulling tension helps ensure the pathway and installation method comply with manufacturer.

Duct Installation of Fiber Optic Cable

Fiber optic cable should not be coiled in a continuous direction except for lengths of 100 ft (30 m) or less. The preferred size for the figure-eight coil is about 15 ft (4.5 m) in length, with each loop 5 ft (1.5 m)

The FOA Reference For Fiber Optics-Installing Fiber

Check the cable length to make sure the cable being pulled is long enough for the run to prevent having to splice fiber and provide special protection for the splices.
