Can I aggregate multiple uplink ports between Ethernet switches?

No. Running multiple connections between switches causes bridge loops which in turn cause broadcast storms that'll bring down the network. One solution is using a spanning tree protocol (RSTP/MSTP)

Port Aggregation FAQs

MC-LAG (Multi-Chassis Link Aggregation Group) allows two switches to work together as a single logical unit, providing both load balancing and redundancy.
