

How to fix fiber optic cable lines to the wall



Overview

Secure cables in trays or conduit and fasten with hook-and-loop ties to prevent compression. For ducted runs, clear the conduit and use a silicone-based lubricant compatible with the cable jacket. A fiber wall socket (also called an optical termination outlet or FTTH outlet) is the critical endpoint where your home's fiber optic cable connects to the Optical Network Terminal (ONT). It ensures a clean, stable interface between the ISP's fiber network and your router—impacting speed, latency. Running fiber internally involves extending this high-speed link from the service entry point to a centralized location, such as a dedicated media closet or network rack. The processes. Once your plan is in place, the next step is to lay your cable. I have fiber optic cable (white plastic, about 1mm in diameter) running into my unit, installed by the provider.
