

How to install protective pads for distribution boxes



Overview

This video shows how to properly install Hilti CP617 firestop putty pads in line with BS standards to protect electrical boxes and switches in drywalls. It demonstrates how to fit CP617 to the inside or the outside of the box. Fitting Isover Protect Putty Pads will reinstate the fire rating of the partition for up to two hours (depending on the partition fire rating) and prevent the passage of smoke and flames in a fire, and sound and air movement during service life, through the electrical penetration to electrical boxes or other penetrants. Faced on both sides with a poly liner, SpecSeal® Putty Pads are easy to use as a through-penetration sealing product. The SSP4S pad is conveniently sized to fit a common 1. When the wallboard is installed against the outlet box a tight seal is achieved. To ensure a high-quality seal, ensure the socket box is clean, dry and free from any dirt and dust. (can be installed to either the inside or the outside of the socket, depending on the direction of the wall). When protective material is used on outlet boxes on both sides of the wall as directed, the horizontal separation between outlet boxes on opposite sides of the wall may be less than 24 in. provided that the boxes are not installed back-to-back (unless otherwise indicated).
