TIA-568 defines three polarity methods: Type A, Type B, and Type C. They differ in how fiber positions 1 through 12 map across the trunk and at the patch panel, and in how the connector gender (key-up vs key-down) is oriented at each end. Method C: Pairwise flipped in the trunk itself. Mixing A, B, and C creates chaos. Trunks are often pinned (male).
