

Run the light circuit from the distribution box



Overview

The first thing to do is to run a length of cable from the supply (distribution board) to the light itself. DO NOT connect this cable to the live supply! This must only be done after the whole circuit is finished and fully tested to comply with BS 7671. This project involves installing a new branch circuit, which consists of a dedicated circuit breaker, the cable run, and the final connection at the switch.
