In a known method for improving the fire retardancy of a wall having an opening for letting a cable tray through, firestop mortar and/or fire retardant sealant, cement or glue is used to fill up any opening remaining after installing the cable tray and the corresponding cables extending through. Cables, cable bundles, conduits, bundles of conduits, empty pipes, cable trays and cable ladders may also pass through penetration seals in walls and floors and should be taken into consideration during all phases of design and application.
