The temporary power distribution box receives the incoming power through the power inlet and then distributes it to each branch circuit through the busbars. The circuit breaker must safely interrupt fault currents, protect conductors and equipment, and. A temporary power distribution box (TPDB), often called a spider box, functions as a portable electrical hub that centralizes and protects power distribution on a job site.
