

The function of fiber optic to single-mode multimode converters

How it works: The cable has a single-mode fiber on one end that is precisely offset-spliced to a multi-mode fiber on the other end. This controlled launch condition prevents the differential mode delay (DMD) that cripples direct connections. This is where fiber conversion comes in.
